Dear Versatile Gun Dog Owners:

We are looking forward to a great test weekend this spring. We will be holding the BWPGCA test at the Mazomanie Wildlife Area about 25 miles south of Baraboo, Wisconsin. Visit our web page at: <https://bohemiangriffon.org/progeny-testing/heartland-tests/> to download fillable entry forms and make meal reservations. NAT and IHDT are required for BWPGCA registered dogs, but other versatile gun dogs are welcome. See the test flyer for details on motels and a map to the test grounds. Take note that there will be dog-friendly rooms available at the Motel 6 north of Baraboo.

Enclosed is your entry form for testing your dog at the Spring Test in Wisconsin. [Note: We prefer that you complete and print the on-line form available on the website.]; also included are the flyer, Cornell University Project health data forms, (for IHDT entries only) and a return slip for the No-Host Dinner. We will be starting at 7:30 AM each morning. Please note that we will only be testing on Saturday and Sunday this spring due to the Judges Seminar being held on Friday.

Please go online to complete the meal reservation form or return the No-Host Dinner Slip along with your application. **NOTE THE NEW VENUE FOR DINNER AND JUDGES SEMINAR IS THE COACH HOUSE 114 W Broadway St, Rock Springs, WI 53961.** We are not asking for dinner money at this time, we just need numbers as early as possible so we can let the caterer know how many to plan for. We will be having our usual Pizza Night at the Baraboo Pizza Ranch on Friday evening.

Please get your application in early. The deadline is March 15th but we would really appreciate if you sent it as soon as possible. We will hold your check until the application deadline if you wish. Please let us know immediately if you cannot test your dog, or if you plan to test with a different chapter.

We will be looking for bird handlers and photographers for the test so if you will be willing to help please let us know.

Early entries would help us out tremendously. Post-dated checks will be accepted and held until date on check.

Dogs are eligible for the Natural Ability Test from the age of 6 months up until and including the day they reach 16 months of age. Dogs over age may be entered for evaluation only. Dogs are eligible for the Intermediate Hunting Dog Test from 12 to 24 months of age. Dogs over 24 months of age may be entered under the special category of Older Hunting Dog Test and will be judged more severely in obedience based upon their age. Dogs over 18 months of age are eligible for the Utility Field Test. Versatile breeds other than Cesky Fousek (Bohemian Wirehaired Pointing Griffons) are eligible and welcome for all tests. 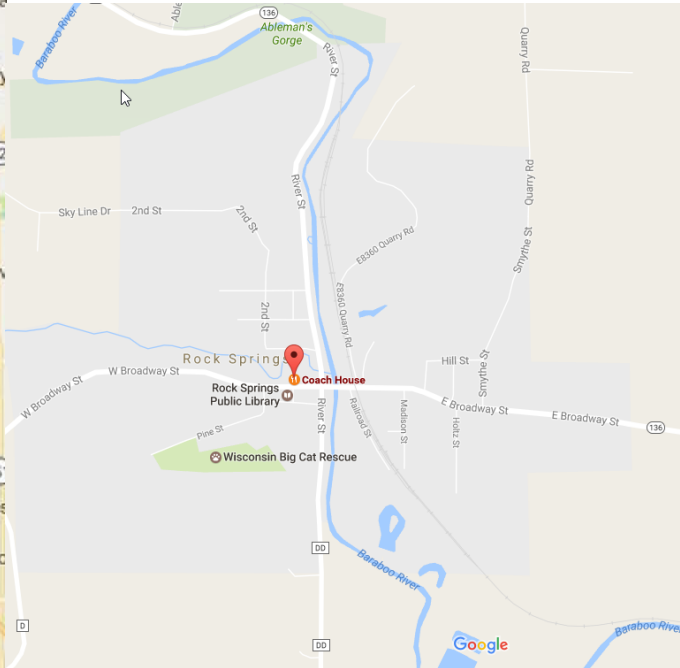

Lunch will be available at the test site on test days.



**Please** - remember that cars kill dogs. Keep your dog on a leash at all times when in the vicinity of a road or driveway. Do not rely on a well trained dog.  
**Use A leash.**

Owners of all dogs on the test site - whether or not the dog is entered in a test - must have proof of the following vaccinations: Rabies, Parvo/DHP/L.  
**No dog will be allowed on the test site without this documentation.**

Please note that WPGCA and chapter clubs are not responsible for injuries to persons or dogs at the test site. Field and water conditions, as with your own hunting grounds, may contain fences, rocks, stumps, holes, or hidden objects that could cause injury.

A No-Host Dinner will be at the **Coach House Restaurant** in Rock Springs, WI 7:00 PM Saturday evening. Note: This is a new location for dinner. See the map. Please complete the on-line form or contact us by phone, email, if you plan to attend.

**Please remember to make your reservations early.**

- At any of these motels remember: **1)** Always keep your dog on a leash. **2)** Make sure your dog is dry before bringing it in the room. Bring a towel from home to wipe down your dog. If for some reason you need to bathe your dog, please clean up the hair etc. in tub. **3)** Do not leave your dog unattended in the room, even in a kennel.
- 4)** Do not allow your dog to bark in the vehicle in parking lot.
