We now have a test site at the Penobscot County Conservation Association (PCCA) Richard Macleod Wildlife Management Area.



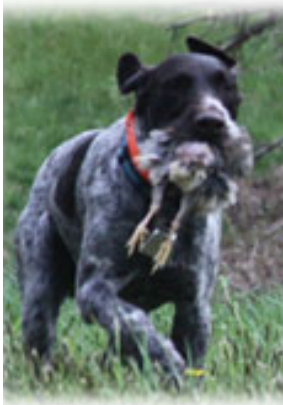

Please note that CFNA and Northeast Chapter are not responsible for injuries to persons or dogs at the test site. Field and water conditions may contain fences, rocks, stumps, holes, or hidden objects that could cause injury.

If there are puppies too young to test, we will give them an opportunity to chase a game bird. Cost will depend on the birds used. Let me know well in advance so I can order birds.
